GEORGIA BREAKS TRADE RECORDS IN 2024

In 2024, Georgia's resilience in global trade continued, achieving 6.4% export growth, surpassing the national average of 2.3%. This marks the fourth year of record growth for the State as well as a 37% increase over the last decade. Georgia's diverse industry sectors continue to drive its success in the global market.

Sixty-six percent of exports and 83% of total trade originated in strategic markets where Georgia maintains international representation to connect local exporters to global opportunities. Georgia moved up to the sixth-largest state in the United States for total trade, spanning 222 unique countries and territories. Total trade and import growth underscore Georgia's strength as a global gateway and logistics expert, carrying product efficiently to the larger U.S. market.










